

# Smith Product Slider Module v.2.10



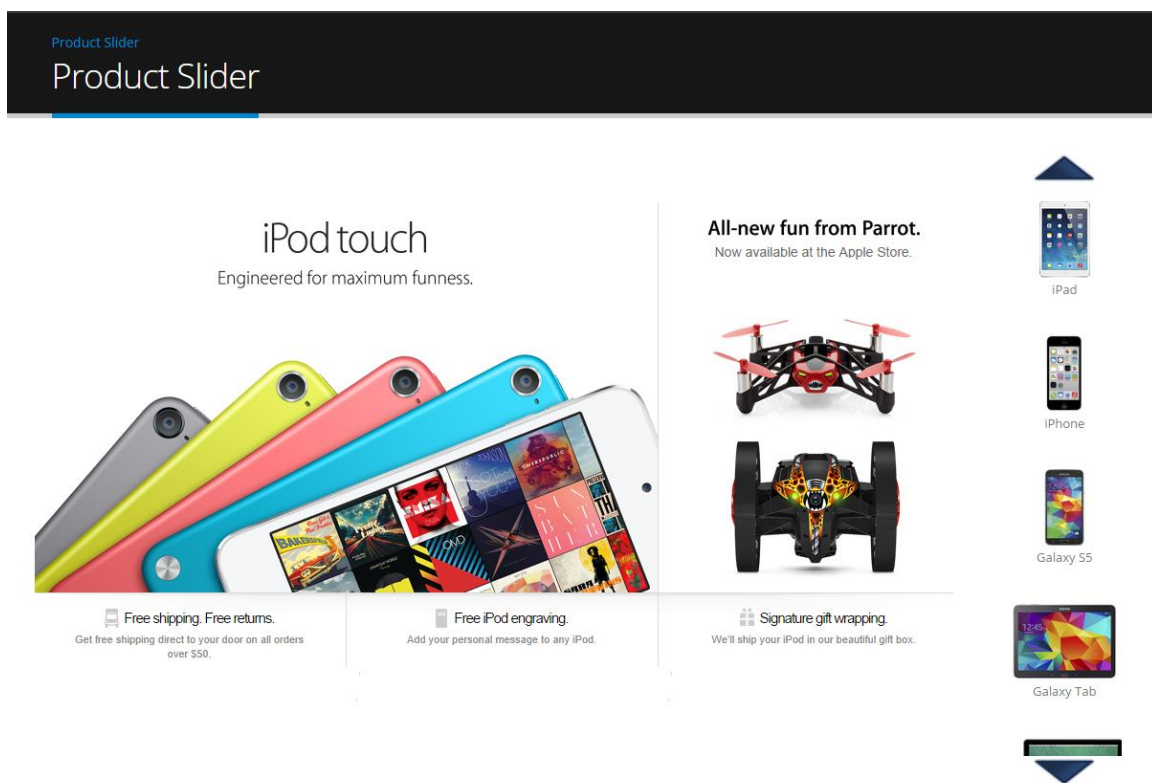
## Users' Manual

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## I. Introduction

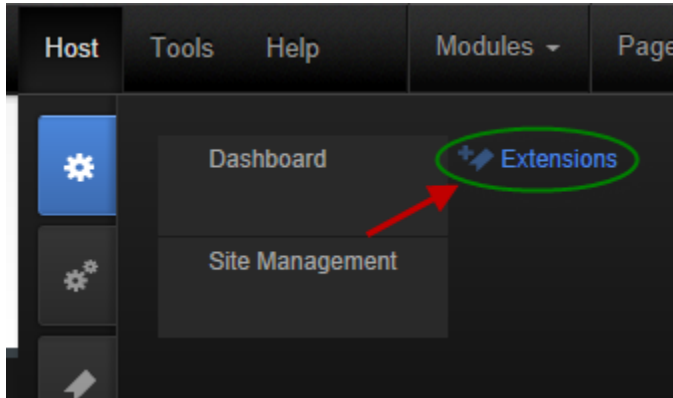
The Smith Product Slider module is a new and innovative way to display your products to your customers. When placed on the front page of your website, the module is able to highlight the featured products and variants you have created within your Smith Cart Module, while giving your website a professional and polished appearance.



## II. Installation

The Smith Slider module is delivered as a standard DNN installable zip or PA (Private Assembly). You install the Smith Slider module just like you would install any other DNN module. Before installing any module it's a good idea to back up your DNN database and DNN installation folder. This is very important, as you can always roll back to previous status easily if installation goes wrong.

**Step 1** - Log in to your DNN site using a Host account. From the DNN host menu, select the Module Extensions link to install the module. In order to do that, you should login as host, or an administrator account with module upload permissions.

You can reach Module Extensions from the Host menu item as shown in figure 1 above. Install the new module from the Host -> Modules menu in DNN.

**Step 2** - Install New Module

On the Module Extensions screen (figure 2), choose Install Extension Wizard from the actions menu. This action menu can be either on the left or right side of the main container. It depends on the layout of your current DotNetNuke skin.

**Step 3** - Browse the ZIP File

Remember the place where you saved the module ZIP file you downloaded? Then browse it.

### Upload New Extension Package

DotNetNuke can be extended in many ways. This wizard helps you upload and install DotNetNuke extension packages.

Use the Choose File button to browse your local file system to find the extension package you wish to install, then click Next to continue.

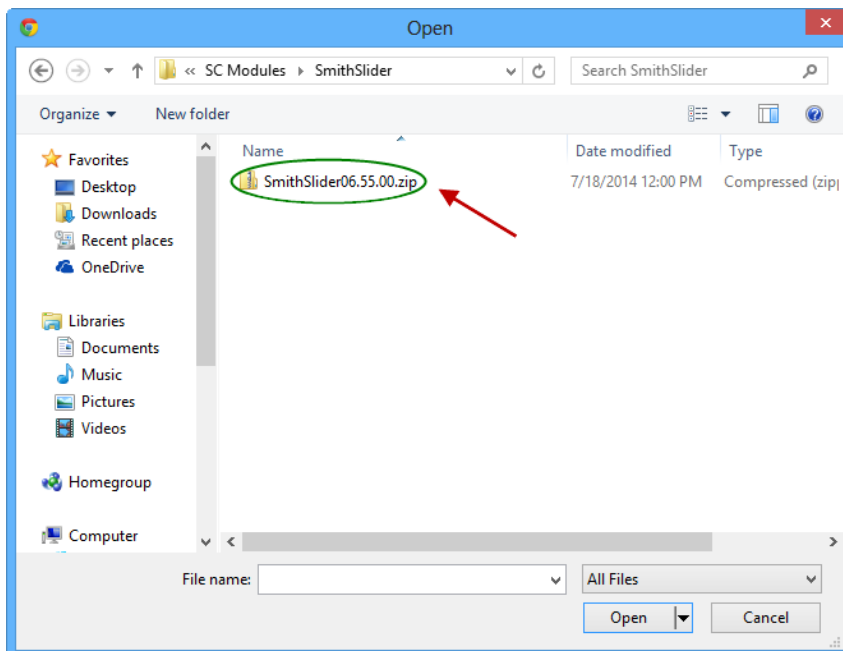

### Step 4 - Pick the file

After you accessed the file, choose it and click Next.

**Step 5 - Add the File**

The file appears in the textbox. Check it once again and then click Next.

Use the Choose File button to browse your local file system to find the extension package you wish to install, then click Next to continue.

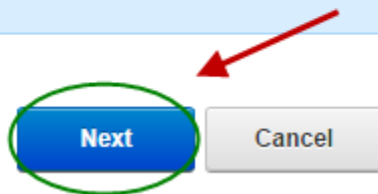


Figure 5 – Install New Module

**Step 6 – Install it now!**

When you see it appear on text area box, click Next and go through the DNN install module wizard.

**Step 7 - Module Installed**

If you do not see any error messages, it means that the module is installed correctly. Click the Return link.

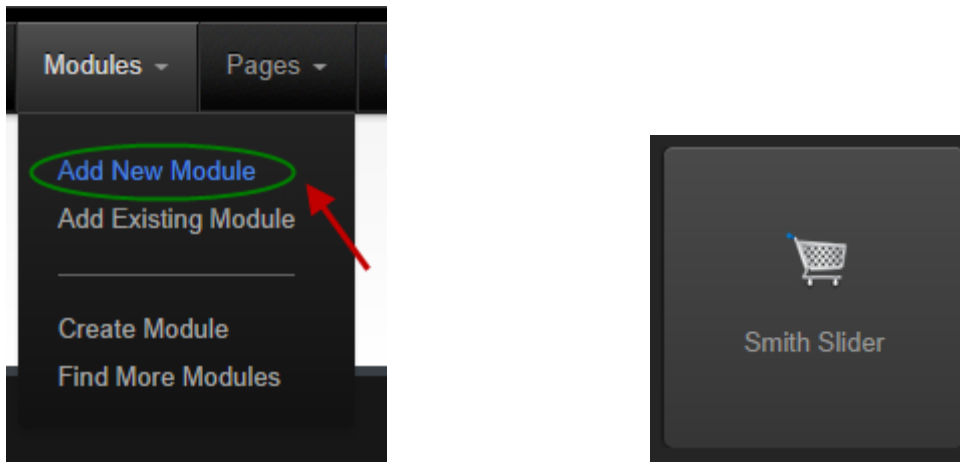

When everything is OK, you should see the Smith Slider module on the Module list on upper panel. Now you can use the module.



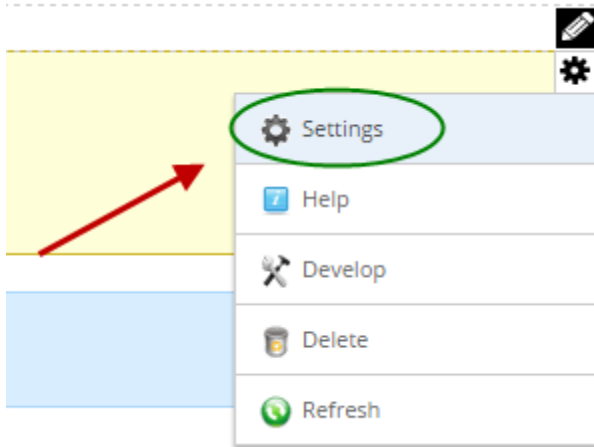
**Step 9** – Create a new page in your DNN portal and drag the Smith Slider module to the desired pane on your page.

### III. Setup and Configuration

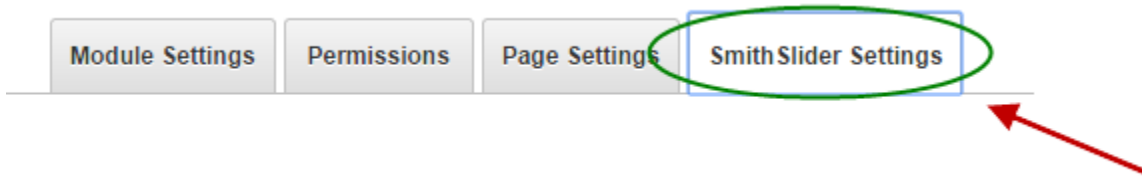
The following sections describe how to configure the Smith Product Slider Module. To access the settings for your Smith Product Slider, follow the steps seen below.

#### A. *Product Slider Settings*


To access your module settings, navigate to the page you have added the Smith Product Slider to. Hover over the “Manage” button click the “Settings” link as seen in the screenshot below:



Then Access the Slider tab:



You will then see the following settings:

**Product Details Page** – Choose the page that you have configured for your Product Details module. This page will display when a user clicks on an item inside the Product Slider Module.

**Data Source** – Choose which products appear inside the Product Slider Module.

**Featured Products** – Slider displays products that have been marked as featured on the product setup screen in the cart.

**Recommended Products** – Slider displays products based on your buying history, items frequently purchased together, and related products.

**Button Type** – Choose the buttons you would like to display on your product Slider.

**Item Width** – Enter the width in pixels of an individual item to be displayed in the Smith Product Slider.

**Item Height** – Enter the height in pixels of an individual item to be displayed in the Smith Product Slider.

**Items** – Choose how many items should be displayed at once.

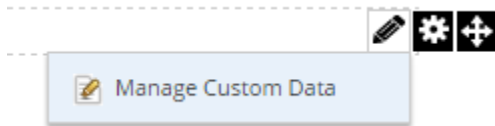
**Scroll Duration** – This setting controls the speed of your module.

**Orientation** – This setting determines whether your products slide vertically or horizontally.

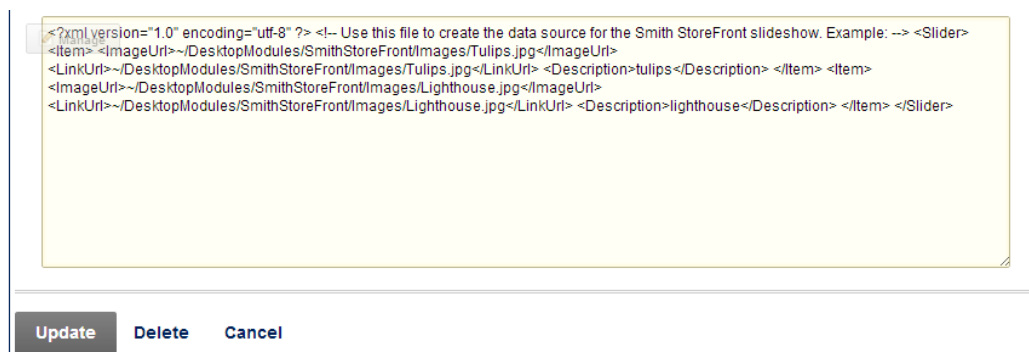
## B. Managing the Product Slider

The Product Slider adds a sophisticated look to your web page. You can customize the images that are displayed through an XML file.

Hover over the “Manage” button and click the “Manage Custom Data” link:



Then use the text box to import the XML file.



**XML Schema** - All elements are optional, custom elements are allowed. Appearance can be customized with SlideShowTemplate.ascx.
